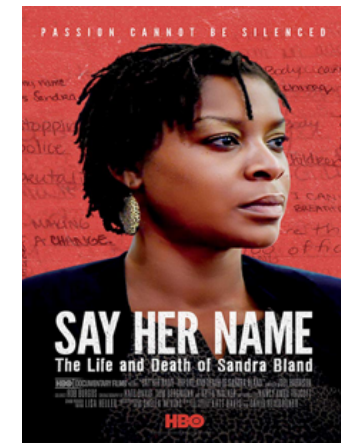
Minding the Gap Wednesday, May 8 6:30-8:30 PM
